Job Requirements

Job Description Summary

The Senior Installation Technician is responsible for various installation activities including, but not limited to: pre-wire on new and retrofit construction, installation of audio, video, security and home automation systems, setup of computer networks and computer systems, pick up of supplies and materials and other duties. The Senior Installation Technician will be on a job site with and without direct supervision. The Senior Installation Technician should have a demonstrated expertise with one or more systems: Phone, Computer, Audio/Video, Lighting Control, Security.

Reporting Relationships

The Installation Technician reports to the Project Manager and may be supervised by a Team Leader on a job site.
